As a YUCA student I am agreeing to the following:

1. I will attend 10 consecutive weeks (6 hrs each week) September 13th - November 15th, 2016 (Portfolios presented November 19th at the YUCA studio). I agree to notify my instructor of any planned absence 24 hours prior to the start of my class; please adhere to YUCA's admissions manual (provided upon entry into the program).
2. I agree and understand that behavior which violates YUCA rules and regulations can lead to a suspension of from program. While this list is not all inclusive, these behaviors are not allowed:
